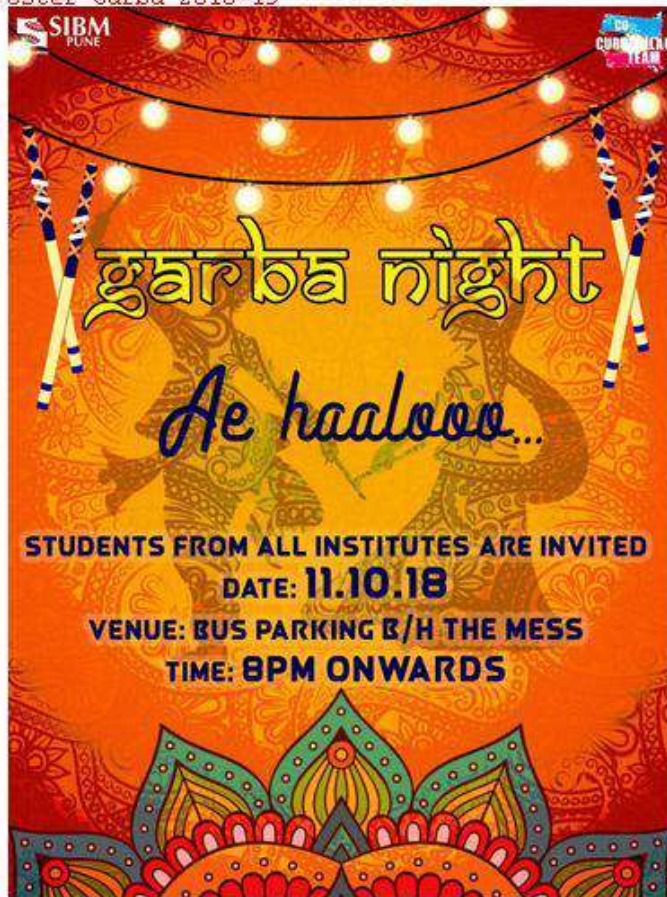

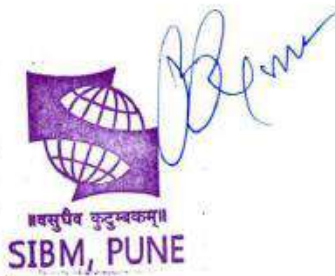

International Mother Language Day is commemorated worldwide to recognize linguistic diversity and promote multiculturalism, which is observed in India as Matribhasha Divas. The Social, Entrepreneurship and Consulting Cell (SECC) upheld this tradition by conducting an event to celebrate "Matribhasha Divas" on 21st February 2019.
