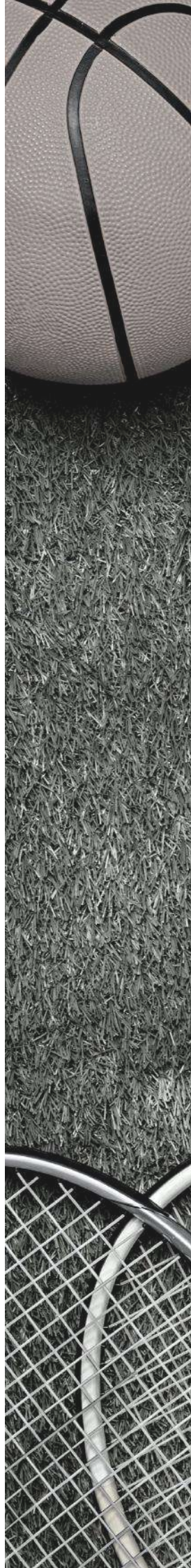

Project Milaap

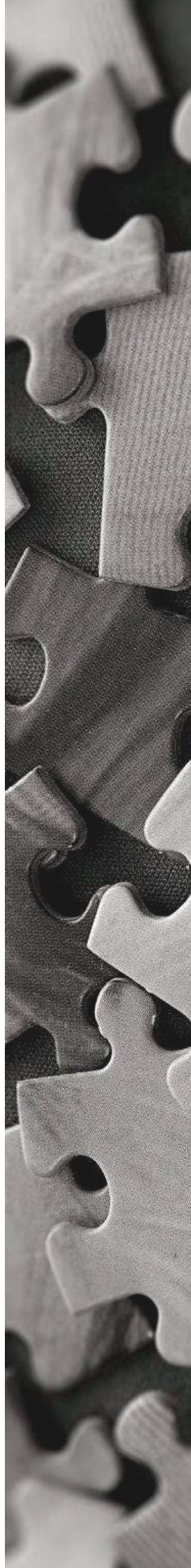

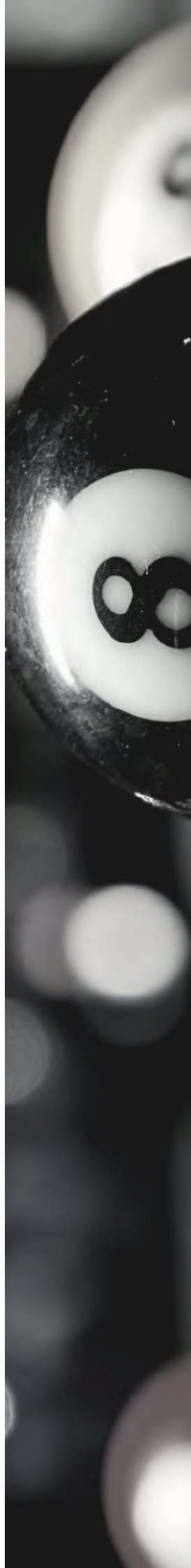

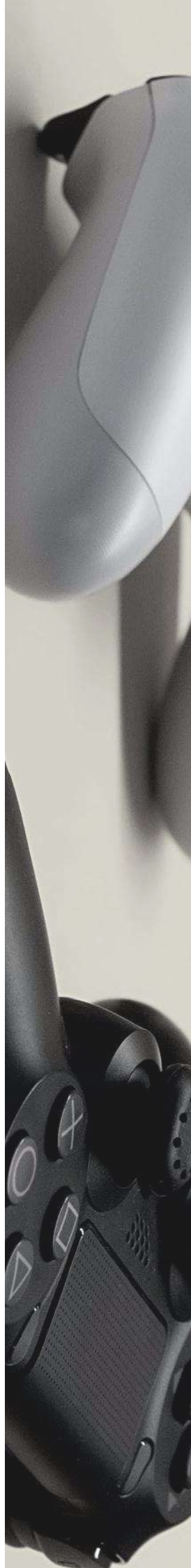
Among us

With another event added to the roster, the Sports Management Team continued to innovate its approach to events, showing again the importance of batch engagement and adding to the students' B-School life experience.





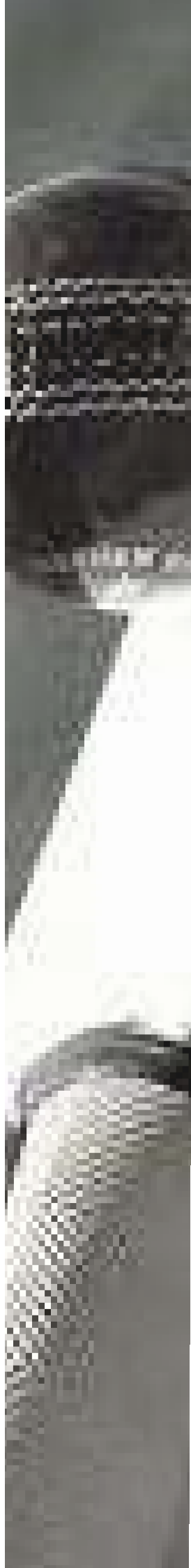
