PROJECT II- SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Students have been given the following instructions and guidelines:

The project is divided into two parts.

Part I. To identify a social problem in consultation with the faculty guide:

Students must visit NGOs/relevant authorities supporting the chosen cause for this purpose & permission. They are expected to analytically study it, making reasoned arguments to support the acknowledgment of the issue as a social problem with a solution oriented approach. The topics could be wide ranging. Some examples: raising awareness of sustainability and social responsibility, and motivating stakeholders to act on them. E.g. issues affecting traffic personnel; issues like violence in any form irrespective of age, gender, or orientation; issues affecting community; hygiene; waste management; environmental concerns- tree plantation; remedial teaching; sports training; financial literacy; digital literacy, etc.

Part II. Raising public awareness about the social problem/issue:

In this section of the assignment, students are required to typify the problem for others. The purpose is to give them some experience in presenting this information to a larger audience to create awareness through various mediums which are **free of cost** and have **maximum impact**. This campaign must run for at least 1-2 weeks. E.g. through street plays, digital media etc.

- Details about the project undertaken, visits- NGOs/relevant authorities (500 words)
- A blueprint of activities with respect to the task undertaken and future plan. (Flowchart)
- Proof of their work in the form of permission letters/emails with official stamp and/or official email ids; photos; bi-weekly logs and observations.
