<u>Finance workshops</u> by collaborating with **FinShiksha** and conducting sessions which threw light on the different career profiles in finance for our juniors and a workshop about Excel and Industry Valuations which will help us ace our internships.

<u>Competitions:</u> where we provide a platform for our students to compare and analyse where we stand in competing with students from IIMs, NMIMS, SCMHRD etc. We have conducted the below competitions-

• <u>Case Latte-The Case Study Competition</u> on Payments Banks, was conducted in collaboration with **SECC**. This was aimed to improve the status of financial inclusion in our country. We had participants from B-Schools across the country.



- Mocafino-The Mock Stock Competition to assess the Stock Market Skills, we collaborated with FinThings- an online virtual trading platform, and provided live trading platform to our participants giving them real-time experience of a finance manager.
- Expresso-The Mock Parliamentary debate was an intra-college competition, on the topic- "Should Religious institutions like temples, churches, Mosques etc. remain Tax exempt?
